

What does the actiposture™ mark mean?

The actiposture™ mark is a brand exclusively applied to advanced postural seating systems designed and developed by designers Professor Richard Snell and David Rowe and, in the case of the Opus Collection, in collaboration with the Birmingham City University (BCU).

It can be found on all Opus musician posture chairs and stools that incorporate a back rest.

actiposture™ proactive seating principles acknowledge that sitting is not a static activity, and that in different situations several functions have to be facilitated by a unique configuration and contouring of seats and backs.

When applied to seating for musicians, the principles involve providing appropriate seat and back profiles to the spine and posterior of players while they support and play musical instruments, allowing for necessary movements and for musculo-skeletal requirements.

All Opus chairs and stools incorporating back rests and marked with the actiposture™ logo are designed and manufactured using actiposture™ principles.
